### **New Field Online Learning Program**

If students have access to technology at home they may use these programs as many times as they like or at least once a day. Students will be given an assignment once a week in their Brainpop accounts. They will need to click on their dashboard within their brainpop account to complete their assignments. They will also continue their online learning in reading and math through their Compass Learning program. Compass Learning is a program that is tailored to each students own learning path. When students log into CL they will need to use their Cps username. The username and password are the same when logging into CL.

All K-4 Students may access any of their online learning programs through their Clever accounts. K-3 students can access Clever Via their QR codes and 4th grade will log into Clever Via their CPS Credentials. Students should bring home their QR codes on Monday March 16.
