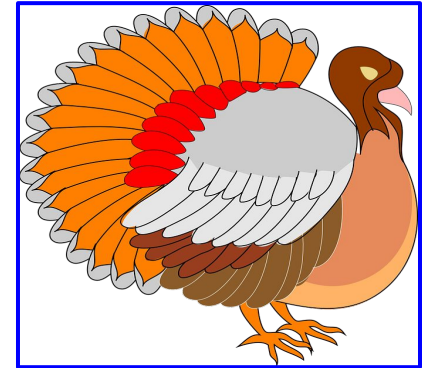

Kindergarten Content

Reading - We will continue to focus on letter identification, letter sounds, sight words, and the blending of short vowel (cvc) words. Letters include: v, w, y, x, z, q, while handwriting addresses forming uppercase letters.

Writing - Students continue to strengthen their skills in illustrating, labeling (spelling objects) and being exposed to sentence structure.

Math - We will be working with verbal counting, number identification, and shapes.

Reminder: We will continue to go outside for recess daily, please make sure your child brings a coat, hat and gloves this fall/winter.
