In reading, we continue to work on learning letters and sounds: a, g, d, s, e, r, p, & j. Sight words for the month of October include: the, my, see, like, & she/he/we. During small reading groups we will begin to learn beginning reading behaviors. In math, we are reinforcing the writing of numbers and counting with one to one correspondence with a focus on the numbers 9-14. In writing, we continue to work on drawing, labeling, and adding details.
