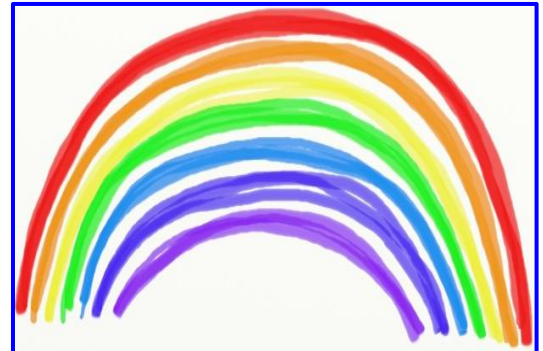

### Curriculum Notes

**Reading:** We are now entering Module 4 of Readers Workshop. This unit focuses on comprehension and expressive reading.

**Writing:** We will continue writing how-to books that teach others step-by-step with pictures and words. After this unit, students will learn to write persuasive pieces to express their opinions and make their world a better place.

**Math:** We continue to work on story problems which include subtraction, addition, and decomposition.

**Science:** Students are learning about living things and what they need to survive.

**Music:** In March, students will continue to learn new songs and play rhythm games.

**Physical Education:** In March, students will work on the skill of striking with their hands and feet and learn how healthy choices help make their bodies healthy.
